#### Bringing SNAP Enrollment to Parish Communities

Did you know that many families qualify for the federal Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) but do not even apply? SNAP helps families buy nutritious foods with an electronic benefit transfer (EBT) card, similar to a debit card. Catholic Charities Case Managers help families complete the SNAP application in a matter of minutes! Catholic Charities started offering this service on-site in our affordable housing communities and at individual parishes. St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Dubuque is one site where these services are offered in conjunction with the free meal program. Removing barriers to accessibility brings help directly to individuals and families who are experiencing food insecurity and need help signing up for SNAP benefits.

#### Suicide Prevention Awareness Month

Suicidal thoughts, much like mental health conditions, can affect anyone regardless of age, gender, or background. In fact, suicide often results from untreated mental health conditions. Suicidal thoughts, although common, should not be considered normal and often indicate more serious issues.

September is Suicide Prevention Awareness Month —a time to raise awareness of this serious public health issue. According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), suicide was responsible for 48,183 deaths in 2021, which is about one death every 11 minutes. - · Average of 22 consults per month
- · 818 individuals served
